Guiding Principles

- Based on your survey response, your child(ren) will receive instruction in-person and remotely on days designated by our school.
- Due to classroom capacity guidelines, in-person instruction will most likely be limited to **2 days per week**. Personalized schedules are forthcoming and will be shared upon creation of the cohorts.
- 6 ft social distancing must be maintained at all times
- Properly fitting masks must be worn at all times when on school property (including outside)
- Each location is a contactless site
- Closing schools, classrooms, or offices is part of the district protocol

Visitors

- To protect everyone's safety, visitors will not be permitted into the school building.
- Being that parents are not permitted into the building, please contact the office in the event that there is an emergency and your child(ren) need(s) to be picked up early.

Transportation

• Shuttle service to and from the ECC/Annex will be limited at this time. (*More information to come.*)

What My Child's Day Will Look Like

Ingress/Arrival

- Student ingress will begin at 8:25 AM. Please adhere to the line-up procedures indicated below:
 - Grades K and 1 Students will enter through the backdoor in the playground at the ECC/Annex.
 - Shuttle service to the ECC/Annex will be limited at this time. (*More information to come.*)
 - Grades 2 through 8 Students will line up on designated color-coded paw prints at the main building.
- 4-Step Ingress Procedures
 - Symptom Screener (Activity Scheduler Mobile App forthcoming)
 - Temperature Check
 - Footwear Sanitizing
 - Hand Sanitizing



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Egress/Dismissal

- To ensure safety, **dismissal** for students receiving in-person instruction (hybrid model) will be staggered **ending at 1:30 PM**.
- Students exit from the same locations from which they entered in the morning.
- Parents/guardians must make arrangements for a timely pickup by the 1:30 PM dismissal.
- Once students are dismissed, they will not be allowed to reenter the building.
- Students must go home immediately after dismissal. In order to maintain everyone's safety, students are not allowed to remain on school grounds.
- After-school programs will remain virtual at this time unless otherwise noted.

Breakfast, Snack, & Lunch

- Grades K-2 Breakfast, snack, and lunch will be provided by the district and eaten in the classroom.
- **Grades 3-8** Breakfast and a snack meal will be provided and eaten in the classroom. Lunch will be provided at dismissal time as a "Grab and Go" meal to be eaten at home.

What My Child Should Bring To School On Scheduled Days

- Face Masks (Face Masks MUST be worn at all times)
- Backpack/Book bag
- Chromebooks and Chargers
- Headphones
- Water Bottle (You may consider labeling the water bottle with your child's name and providing a straw.)
- Pencils
- Notebooks
