
# **School Logistics / Procedures**

#### First Day of School and Start/Dismissal Times

The first day of school is Tuesday, September 7, 2021. School start time is 8:25am and dismissal time is 2:55pm. Van Wagenen street gate will be opened at 8am to begin the 4-Step Covid-19 Ingress Procedure.

#### **Ingress and Egress Procedures (MAP)**

- Families are to complete the <u>Daily Health Screening</u> via the app, RST Mobile Application, by 8am (prior to arriving at the school).
- Van Wagenen Gate will open at 8am to welcome families who arrive before 8:25am.
- Grades PK-7 will stand in a designated area on the playground during Ingress and Egress times. Parents will be highly encouraged to leave the students in the playground for Grades 4-7, with the supervision of staff.
- All students will go through a 4-step process when entering the building. The four step process includes: Health Screening Questionnaire, Temperature Check, Foot Sanitizing and Hand Washing/Sanitizing.





#### **Health and Safety Procedures**

Our priority has always been the safety of our students, parents, staff, and school community on a daily basis. There are specific procedures that will be followed during the start and end of the school day to ensure the health and safety of everyone. Below are the measures that will be taking place at Roberto Clemente:

- During Ingress, students will go through a screening process, such as answering health related questions, temperature checks, footwear sanitizing and hand washing / sanitizing before entering the building.
- Three-sided clear desk partitions will be used along with visual cues to ensure the safety procedures are being followed by all.
- Wearing a face mask is required for students / staff entering the building and throughout the day, except while using the restroom or mealtimes. Other exceptions can be discussed based on individual needs.
- Lastly, the school will be equipped with advanced and safe products to clean and sanitize every classroom and areas in the building. Foaming hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom and communal areas throughout the day.
