# Steps to Follow for an Asthma Episode in the Child Care Setting

#### EARLY WARNING SIGNS

- Cough, chest hurts, wheezing
- Changes in behavior: unusually tired, not wanting to play, restlessness, trouble sleeping
- Drop in peak flow
- Exposure to known triggers that result in symptoms

#### **ACTIONS TO TAKE**

Stop activity
Help child to an UPRIGHT position
Remove from trigger if possible



Follow Asthma Action Plan or health care provider's instructions for use of reliever medication



4 Look for improvement



Document in Medication Record



**S** Contact the family



Watch for Late Warning Signs as listed below



### LATE WARNING SIGNS of an emergency

- Chest/neck muscles are working hard
- Struggling to breathe
- Trouble walking or talking
- Breathing or peak flow rate does not improve or is worse after treatment
- Lips/fingernails are gray or blue

## CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY

- Follow the Actions to Take listed above
- Watch the child until help arrives

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
